

Berkhamsted Bowmen's 60th Anniversary and Paul Dunn Memorial Fun Shoot

Berkhamsted Bowmen invite you to help us celebrate our 60th anniversary by joining us in battle against the French king and his army at Lockhart's Field, Cow Roast, near Berkhamsted, Herts, HP23 5RF.

The French soldiers (some on loan from Silver Arrow Archery) will be engaged at a distance of 150 yards. A shorter distance will be available for anyone who cannot make 150 yards). There will be 1 end of sighters. Each end will be timed at 1 minute, during which you can shoot as many arrows as you like. We will then shoot 3 ends at 150 yards followed by 3 ends each at 140, 130, 120, 110 and 100 yards.

First prize, generously donated by Silver Arrow Archery, will go to the first archer to hit the king. This is not as easy as it sounds; Louis le Petit is well named and has a hostage, so take care! The Paul Dunn Memorial Senior and Junior Trophies will go to the top scorers in each category from Berkhamsted Bowmen and there will be additional prizes for best score (visitor), most arrows shot in one minute and more.

Regretfully we cannot accommodate compound bows, but all other bow types are welcome as long as sights and stabilisers are removed.

Anyone who brings a crossbow will have to join the French!!
