Rounds	Double WA70, Double WA60, Double WA50 (Compound) & Double WA50 (Barebow). Individual rounds can be entered; however, priority will be given to those archers entering the double round.
Entry Fees	£15 per round – Archers attending both the morning and afternoon sessions £30
Registration, Assembly and start times	Registration will be available from 08:00. AGB membership cards must be shown at registration. Morning Session - Assembly 09:00, practice will start 09:15 Afternoon Session – Assembly 12:45, practice will start 13:00 <i>[This time is approximate, and we will commence earlier if the afternoon session is complete and ready to start]</i>
Refreshments & Raffle	Subject to availability catering will be available throughout the day, this will be confirmed prior to the event with the target list. There will be raffle tickets available throughout the day
Awards	Awards will be top three scores in each class (subject to entries). previous trophy winners, please remember to return them.
Shooting	Shooting will be done in accordance with AGB rules. There will be a maximum of four archers per boss, shot in two details of six arrows per end using a Chronitor Timing System. Danage foam bosses will be used at the event.
Parking	We will be using the RAF High Wycombe car park opposite the field. [ <a href="https://w3w.co/twice.wisdom.explained">https://w3w.co/twice.wisdom.explained</a> ] We are situated near Lacey Green, just outside High Wycombe. Directions will be included in the target lists if requested. Please let us know if you are disabled and require on-site parking
Dress Code & Photography	AGB dress regulations as shown in Rule 307 will apply. If you wish to take photographs please let us know on the day, you will need to register.
Smoking	Smoking (including e-cigarettes) is only permitted behind the tents. Please do not leave cigarette butts on the ground.
Closing Date	Priority will be for archers entering the double round. Priority places for archers entering the double round will close on 31 <sup>st</sup> March 2026. At this point, single rounds will be allocated to archers who have entered, and the remaining places will be allocated as entries are received. Closing date for all entries is 1 <sup>st</sup> May 2026 or sooner if all places are filled.
